He then progressed into Ministox on short ovals in the UK and Europe in 2014 at the age of 10 and quickly progressed up the ranks within the stockcar formula and made a name for himself becoming a 3x champion. In 2020 Jenson made the move to Circuit racing competing in the shortened COVID season of the Fiesta Junior Championship. In 2021 he won the Fiesta Junior Championship in his first full season and moved on to the Fiesta Championship in 2022 in the ST240 class and won the Championship Overall making him a the first ever back to back Fiesta Junior and Senior Champion.
